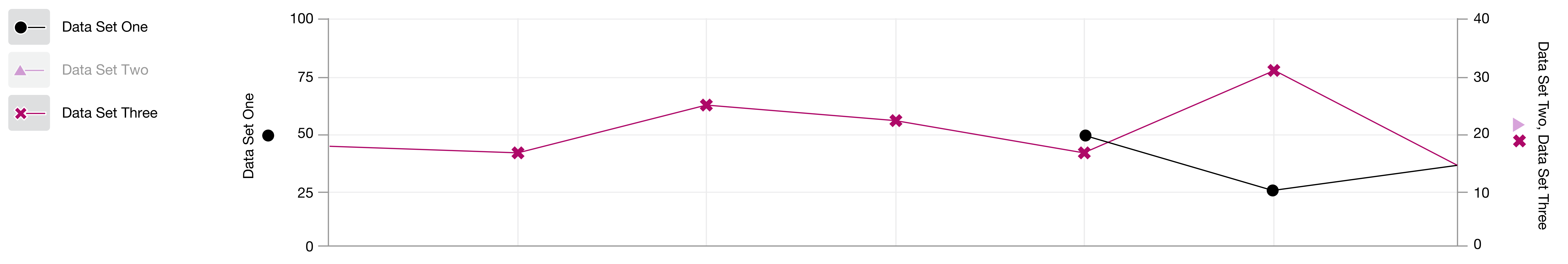
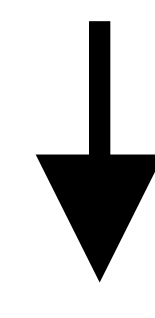
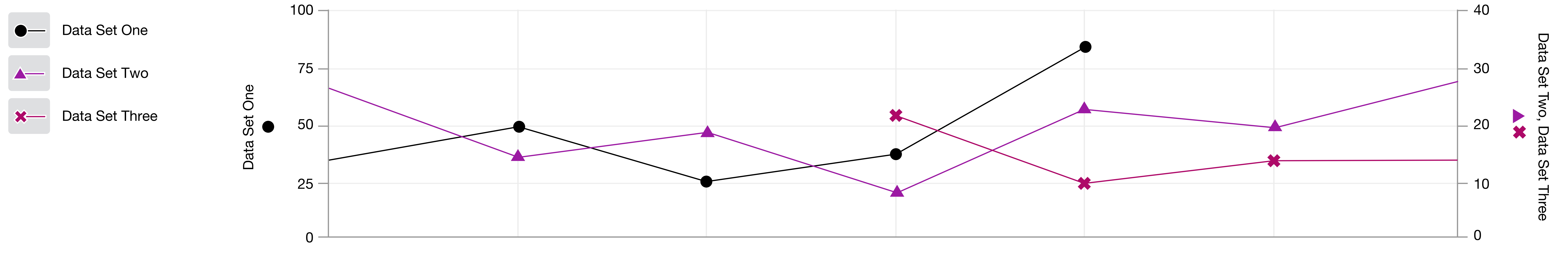

No Data by Individual Data Set

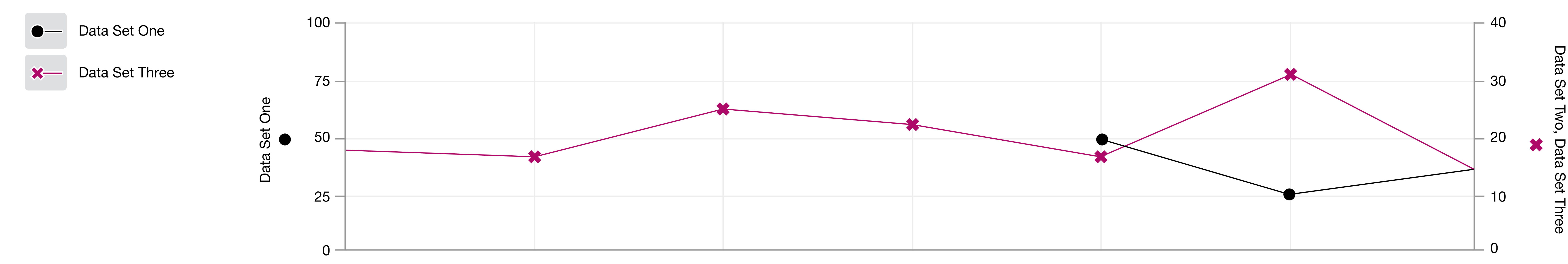
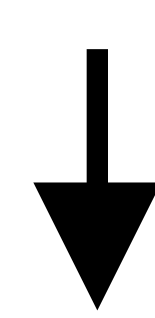
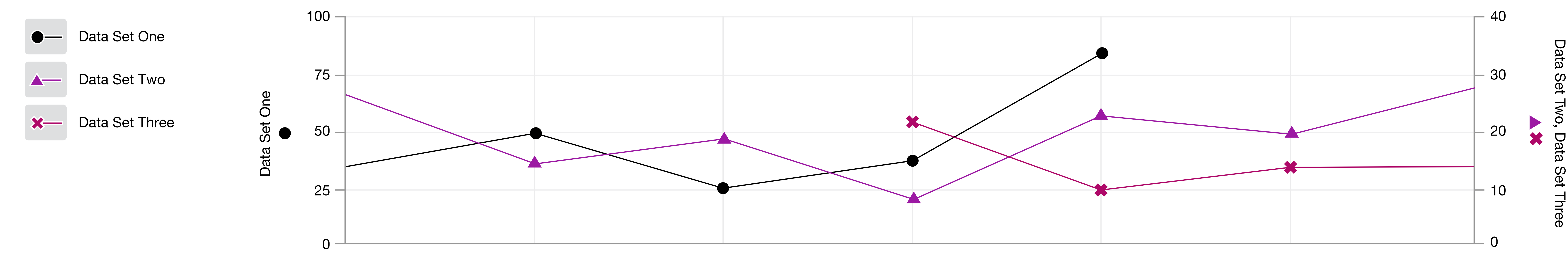
Default behavior:

When there is a y axis range in which a data set has no data, the legend and axis symbol will dither to alert the user is no longer has data (the axis label will not adjust).



Secondary Behavior:

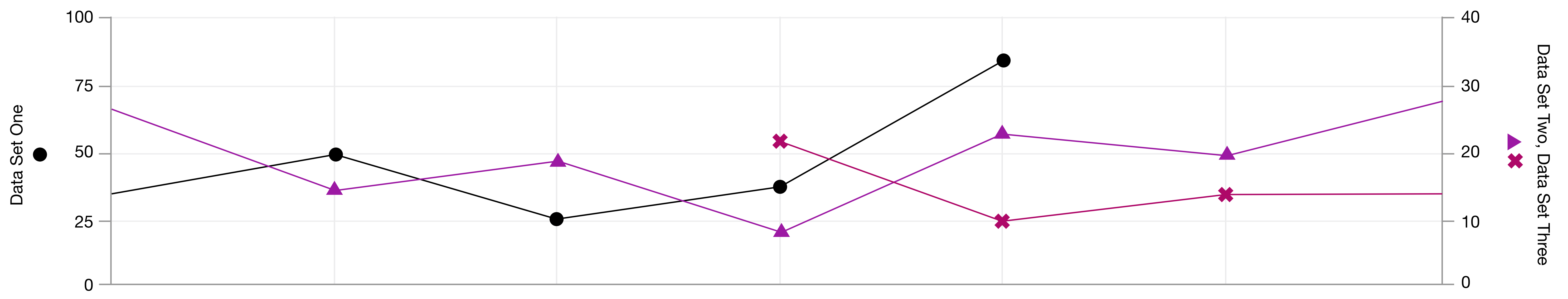
When there is a range in which a data set has no data, the legend and axis symbol will be removed from the ui.



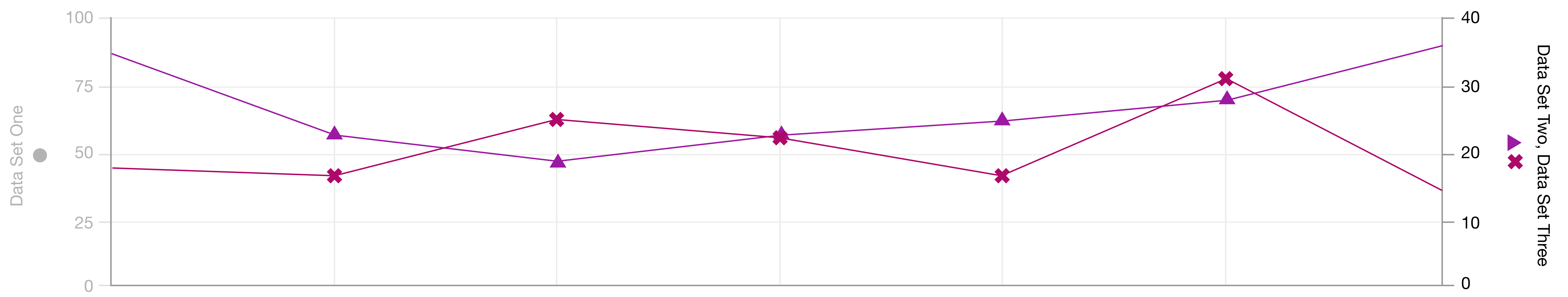
Entire Y Axis has no data:

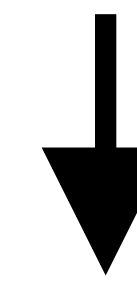
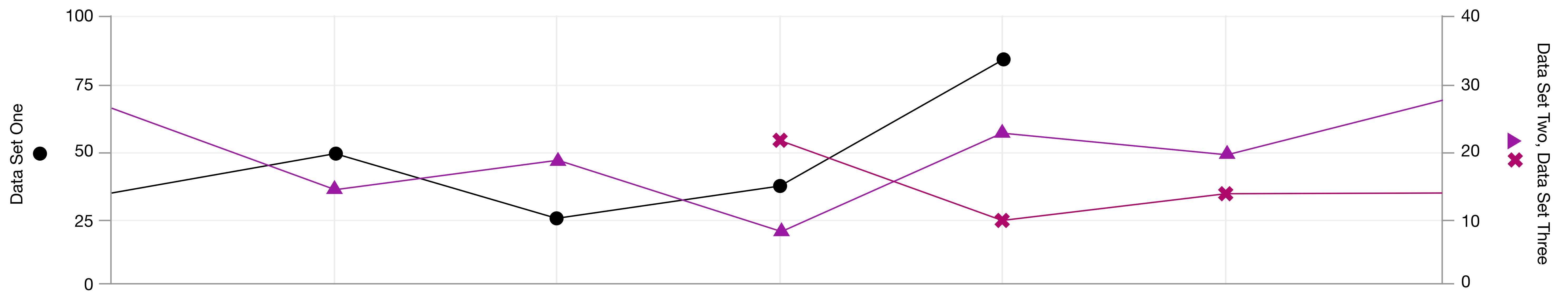


Default: No Data by Graph

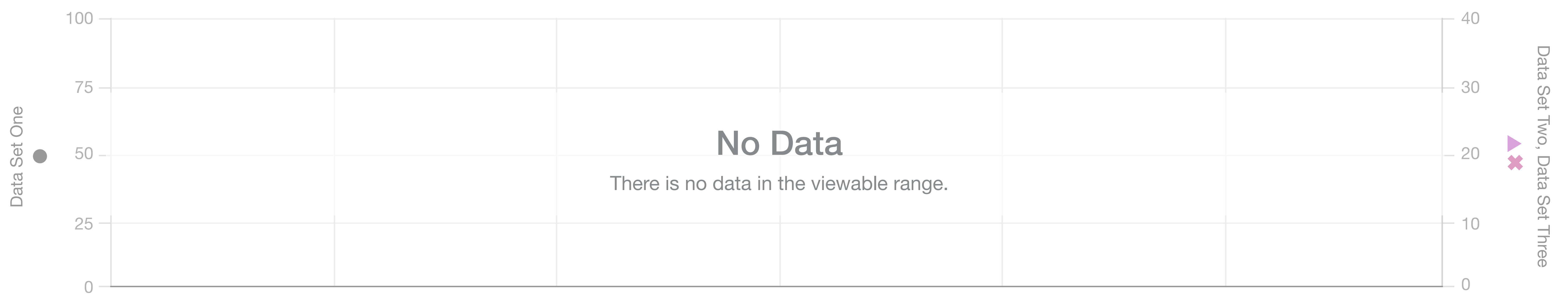
Default behavior:
