All fields in *red* are located in the YAML block at the top of the markdown pages or in YAML files in the data directory of the project.

Shortcodes are surrounded by curly and angle brackets and often make use of YAML files. They extend what can be done with Markdown alone.

The "grid" value determines the number of images in each row.
